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HOMOPHONES AND CONFUSABLES

1. Apostrophe forms: expand them (they are / you are / it is).
2. too = too much or also; two = 2; otherwise to.
3. UK: C = noun (practice), S = verb (practise).
4. could've = could HAVE, never 'could of'.

Example: They're bringing their boots over there.
