

Place Value in Decimals — Cheat Sheet

PLACE VALUE IN DECIMALS

1. Find the decimal point first.
2. Left of the point: ones, tens, hundreds...
3. Right of the point: tenths, hundredths, thousandths...
4. Each place is 10× smaller than the one to its left.

Example: in 352.68 → 3=300, 5=50, 2=2, 6=0.6, 8=0.08
