

Area of Triangles — Cheat Sheet

AREA OF TRIANGLES

1. Area = (base × height) ÷ 2.
2. Height is perpendicular to the base.
3. Multiply first, halve once.
4. Answer in square units.

Examples: b10 h6 → 30 cm² · b4 h7 → 14 m²
