

Converting Capacity — Cheat Sheet

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CONVERTING CAPACITY

1. $1000 \text{ ml} = 1 \text{ l}$.
2. $\text{l} \rightarrow \text{ml}: \times 1000$. $\text{ml} \rightarrow \text{l}: \div 1000$.
3. Same units before calculating.
4. Multi-step: total poured first, then subtract.

Example: $2 \text{ l} - (3 \times 250 \text{ ml}) = 2000 - 750 = 1250 \text{ ml} = 1.25 \text{ l}$
