

Volume of Cuboids — Cheat Sheet

VOLUME OF CUBOIDS

1. Volume = length × width × height.
2. Think: one layer, times the number of layers.
3. Answer in cubic units: cm^3 , m^3 .
4. Any multiplication order works.

Examples: $5 \times 3 \times 4 = 60 \text{ cm}^3$ · $40 \times 30 \times 20 = 24\,000 \text{ cm}^3$
