

Two-Way Tables — Cheat Sheet

TWO-WAY TABLES

1. A cell means row-label AND column-label together.
2. Missing cell = its row (or column) total – the known cells.
3. Cross-check the other direction.
4. Grand total = row totals = column totals.

Example: row 30 with 14 known $\rightarrow$ 16; check $16 + 10 = 26 \checkmark$.
