FOOD CHAINS AND WEBS

1. Every chain starts with a producer (a plant).
2. Consumers eat: herbivore, carnivore, omnivore.
3. Arrows point TO the eater = direction of energy flow.
4. A food web is many food chains joined together.

Example: grass → caterpillar → bird → fox (arrows to the eater).
